General Guidelines

Purpose:

Provide assistance to rural fire departments located in VVEC's service area that do not receive municipal funding. The intended results will be improved rural fire protection infrastructure and reduced fire insurance costs for our Members.

Eligible Activities:

- Capital Improvements. Land purchases for expansion of existing departments and the establishments of new fire departments (land, buildings, equipment, etc.)
- Dry hydrants. The ISO certifies dry hydrants. The rural fire defense program coordinator for the applying department must approve the need for the dry hydrants.
- Equipment. Examples of equipment include vehicles (assigned to rural fires) tools, pumps, hoses, clothing, communications, etc.

Eligible Criteria:

- The proposed projects must be located within the VVEC service area.
- The proposed project must maintain or reduce ISO ratings and/or show other economic benefits to the residents of the community or contribute to the well-being of the community.
- Communities imposing strict boundary limits, which exclude rural residents, part of the community, or using strict subscription response systems will not be considered in this program.

Selection Criteria:

In addition to eligibility, applications are evaluated on the following:

- Needs Assessment
- Other funding
- Assessment of Financial Feasibility
- Program Narrative

Grant Application Process:

- Rural Fire Department submits application
- VVEC staff reviews application
- VVEC staff notifies fire department of application status (approval or denial)
