SCHEDULE AN ENERGY AUDIT AND SAVE!

Want to reduce your energy usage at home? VVEC offers in-home energy audits to help you do just that! A trained auditor will come to your home to conduct one of two types of energy audits to determine the efficiency of your home. The information the auditor gathers will help the auditor determine where you are spending your energy dollars and will help the auditor point out hidden inefficiencies. The auditor will then make practical, useful suggestions to help you use electricity more efficiently and save money on your monthly electric bill.

The Blower Door Audit

- A blower door and infrared camera test to locate places of air leakage and energy loss.
- Inspection of rim joists, windows, doors, recessed lighting, electrical outlets and switches for air leaks.
- Documentation of all air leaks for sealing.
- Check of the heating system filter.
- Visual inspection of the heating and air conditioning duct work for air leaks, if accessible.
- Check of the temperature setting on the water heater.
- Inspection of the attic insulation and determination if any

additional insulation is needed.

- Inspection of the crawl space and basement for any energy efficiency opportunities.
- An energy weatherization kit consisting of a water heater wrap, hot water pipe wrap, three CFL bulbs, insulation kits for electrical outlets and wall switches, a low-flow shower head, a night light, caulk and door sweep/ weather seals.

More easy ways to save energy at home!

ATTIC
In many homes, attic insulation is one of easiest, least expensive and most effective ways to reduce your energy use. Contact us to find out how much insulation is right for your home. In colder regions, a properly insulated attic also reduces the chance of ice dams.

DEN/OFFICE
Plug all electronic gadgets such as phone and laptop chargers, printers, gaming consoles and BluRay players into a power strip with an on/off switch. When not in use, turn the power strip off to eliminate all those energy vampires.

BEDROOM
Ceiling fans can help save energy all year long! In the summer, fans should rotate counter clockwise to push air down creating a cooling flow. In the winter, fans should rotate clockwise to help draw cool air up toward the ceiling and push the warm air that naturally rises down to you and your family.

BATHROOM
Take a short shower instead of a bath. Short showers use much less water, and you'll also save energy by not heating all that extra water!

LIVING ROOM
Smart thermostats learn how you and your family live, and automatically adjust the temperature settings based on your lifestyle to keep you comfortable while saving you money.

KITCHEN
Make sure your burner isn't bigger than the pan, and use flat-bottomed pans to maximize surface contact with the burner. Don't preheat the oven until you're ready to use it. Minimize the number of times you open and close the refrigerator or oven door.

We partner with Associated Electric Cooperative, our wholesale power supplier, to provide energy weatherization kits when we perform this audit. Additionally, a rebate of up to 50% of the cost (up to a maximum of \$500) is available to members taking the corrective actions noted by our auditor at the conclusion of the audit. The blower door audit has a value of over \$400, but we charge only \$100 to have the audit performed. The blower door audit is not available if you have natural gas or propane in your home.

The Walk-Thru Audit

- An infrared camera tests locating places of air leakage and energy loss.
- Inspection of rim joists, windows, doors, recessed lighting, electrical outlets and switches for air leaks.
- Documentation of all air leaks for sealing.
- Check of the heating system filter.
- Visual inspection of the heating and air conditioning duct work for air leaks, if accessible.
- Check of the temperature setting on the water heater.
- Inspection of attic insulation and determination if any additional insulation is needed.
- Inspection of crawl space and basement for any energy efficiency opportunities.

The walk-thru audit is available to all members in lieu of the blower door. This audit does not include a weatherization kit and there are no rebates available. The cost of a walk-thru audit is \$50. ■

What is the Customer Charge?

When you look at your monthly electric bill you see the cost of the electricity you used during that billing period.

There is also another amount that doesn't change from month to month as your usage does. That is the customer charge. But exactly what is the customer charge?

There are costs associated with being able to deliver electric service to a location before even one kilowatt-hour of electricity is used. This is what is covered by the customer charge.

Those include the cost of the meter, wire, poles, and other equipment used to deliver electricity. There are also costs involved with maintaining that location's equipment, and repairing or replacing it when necessary, and the customer charge covers those.

lime gelatin salad

- 6 ounces powdered lime gelatin
- 2 cups boiling water
- 8 ounces softened cream cheese
- 2 cups lemon-lime soda
- 8-ounce tub whipped topping
- 8 ounces crushed pineapple, drained

In a medium bowl, dissolve the gelatin in the boiling water. Add the cream cheese and beat with an electric mixer until well combined. Stir in the soda. Chill until partially set, about 60 to 90 minutes. Fold in the whipped topping and pineapple. Transfer mixture to a serving dish and chill until firm.
